There are 1000 Waldorf Schools scattered across the globe. In Germany there are hundreds of Waldorf Schools.

The children stay together in one class from grades 1 - 12.

No child is left behind or must repeat a class. Here the children can learn without the pressure of grades.

For the head there are intellectual subjects, for the heart artistic ones, and for the will a variety of crafts and practical subjects.

There are only two intercultural Waldorf Schools in Germany. We are founding the third one in Dresden.

Here German children will learn and play together with children from the whole world.

The teachers will be intercultural.

The children will have English and classes in their mother tongue starting in the first grade.

A wide variety of songs, games, celebrations, fairy tales and myths from different cultures will be an integral part of school life.

Three different school leaving exams will be offered, so that each child can take the one that suits him.
